### Annual Report of Activities conducted Prof. (Dr.) Bhagawan Mali

In the academic year 2023-24, several activities were organized in accordance with the guidelines of Savitribai Phule University, Pune, for the social, educational and political development of students through the Student Welfare Association of Savitribai Phule University, Pune and Anekant Education Society's Tuljaram Chaturchand College, Baramati.

Under the scheme Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme, talented, ambitious and needy students were involved. An appeal was made through WhatsApp groups, notices, website to participate in this scheme and forms were filled by the students regarding their financial situation and quality, to participate in the Earn and Learn Scheme. After that a committee of expert professors was formed and after acquiring the information about the students, their interviews were conducted and in this way the students who were really in poor financial condition and needy as well as meritorious were involved in the Earn and Learn Scheme. The selected students were made to participate in the learn-on-the-job scheme for two hours daily in various places like the administrative building, library, gymkhana, various departments of the college, as well as Kavivarya Moropant Botanical Garden. According to their attendance of each month, their stipend would be credited to the students' personal account in the first week of the following month. During these academic years, a total of 173 students benefitted from this scheme and a total of Rs.11,94,480 were credited to students' accounts.

Special Guidance Scheme

A total of 57 proposals under the Special Guidance Scheme were uploaded online and sent to the Student Development Board of Savitribai Phule Pune University. A total of ten proposals were approved by the university through various departments.

The demand was made through some departments for Mushroom Cultivation (Dept. of Botany), Drone Survey (Dept. of Geography), Hidden Treasures of India (Dept. of Culture), Reel Production (Dept. of Journalism and Mass Communication), Dragon Fruit Cultivation (Dept. of Botany), Waste Water Treatment (Dept. of Environment), Solar Lamp Assembly (Dept of Material Science) was implemented by the departments which helped to direct students

for future careers and also to understand students' trend towards entrepreneurship.

### Swarrang 2023
