



MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Notice issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies was successfully held on 10th April 2019 at 11:00 pm in the Department of Defence Studies, T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place offline mode, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Mr. Pushkar Ekbote, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. programme in accordance with 2019 pattern.

The BOS has discussed the course structure of the BA as per the 2019 pattern credit structure guidelines. Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the 2019 pattern.

Resolution No. 1: The course and credit structure for the B.A. programme 2019 pattern has been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.

2. To prepare and approve curriculum of FYBA Semester-I and II (2019 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2019-2020.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of FYBA Semester-I and II, aligning it with the guidelines of the 2019 pattern, for implementation in the academic year 2019-2020. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Devidas V. Bhosale suggested to include chapter of paramilitary forces in the syllabus of DEF-1101(A) course. Prof. Pushkar Ekbote, suggested to add Supporting Arms in the syllabus of DEF-1201(B) course. Devidas Bhosale, suggested to add Principles for war in DEF-1101(B) course. A change was suggested regarding the inclusion of Indirect Approach and Blitzkrieg in the curriculum by Prof. Ramkishan Awad in the DEF-1201(B) course.

The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of FYBA Semester I and II.

Furthermore, members have discussed the objectives and course outcomes. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

Resolution No. 4: Considered and Approved


5. Any other matter with the consent of Chairperson.
