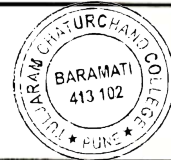

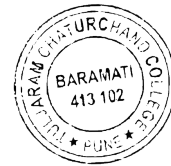

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

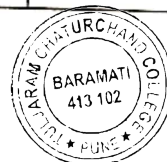

1. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. programme to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20.

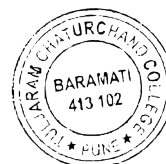
