
Board of Studies Meeting



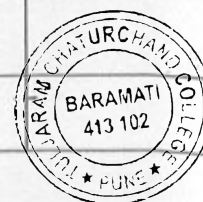

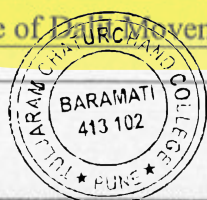

6. Any other matter with the consent of Chairperson.


All the subjects on the agenda were discussed in the meeting, so no issue was raised by any of BOS members.
