

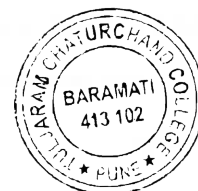

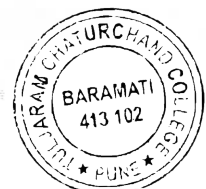

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

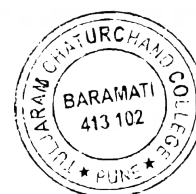

1. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. and M. A. programme in accordance with 2019 pattern

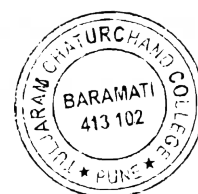
