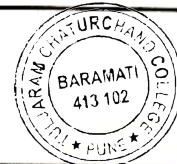



## Board of Studies Meeting



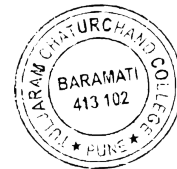

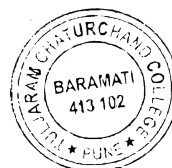

**4. To prepare and approve curriculum of certificate courses for UG and PG programmes as per 2019 pattern.**

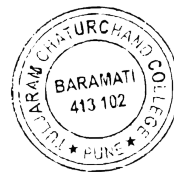

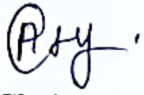
