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Minutes of the Meeting

The Department of Media and Communication Studies successfully held a Board of Studies (BoS) meeting on 25th May 2020. The meeting occurred in online modes due to the Corona pandemic situation, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Chairman, BoS, Journalism and Mass Communication, Mr. Ranjeet Vijay Pandit, HOD, and Assistant Professor, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BoS meeting.

To consider and approve the course syllabus of the Second Year UG and PG (Sem-III) according to the 2019 pattern.

The BoS discussed the course syllabus of S.Y B.Voc JMC and M.Voc MS as per the 2019 pattern credit structure guidelines. Considering the valuable suggestions provided by the BoS members, necessary modifications were made to the course syllabus of semester III for both S.Y B.Voc Journalism and Mass Communication and S.Y M.Voc Media Studies. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final syllabus has been determined. Considered and Approved.

To design and approve the course syllabus of the Second Year UG (Sem–III) according to the 2019 pattern.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of S.Y.BVoc JMC Semester-III, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), for implementation in the academic year 2020-21. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. The most important suggestion from all the members was to reconsider the number of units and hours with respect to the given credits.

Mr. Alok Jatratkar gave suggestions on how to include the issue of ethics in the curriculum of news reporting and editing and what should be the nature of assignments demonstrating the same. At the same time, it was suggested that there should be some flexibility



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in the nature of assignments during the Corona epidemic. Mr. Mithunchandra Choudhary guided the format of writing for the media, asking students to design assignments to motivate them to write.

The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of S.Y.BVoc JMC Semester III: General component subjects JM 201-News reporting and Editing-I, JM 202-Writing for Media-I(Print), JM 203-Indian Constitution were finalized for the skill component JM 204-Language skills- English, JM 205-Feature Writing, JM 206 Photojournalism. These subjects were finalized.

Considered and Approved.

To design and approve the curriculum for M.Voc MS (Semester-III) from the academic year 2020-21.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of M.Voc MS, Semester-III. In this semester, the department provides two specializations, namely Digital Journalism and video production. This syllabus aligns with the guidelines of the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF). Members of BoS gave valuable suggestions for framing the syllabus. During the discussion, Mr. Mithunchandra Chaudhari, who is an expert in Video production, gave valuable inputs on video production.

The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of M.Voc MS, Semester-II: subjects, namely MS 301A Script Writing and Direction, MS 302A Sound and Post-production, MS 303A Film Appreciation, MS 304A Group Project, MS 305A Video Editing, MS 306A Lighting Techniques, MS 301B Digital Journalism, MS 302B Social Media Marketing, MS 303B Advertising, MS 304B Group Project, MS 305B Broadcast journalism, MS 306B Digital Content Development. Furthermore, it was decided to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of three units for the 2-credit courses and six units for the 4-credit courses. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

Approval of the structure of the UG (semester IV) and PG (Semester-IV): In this meeting, all members of BoS approved the structure of the upcoming IV semester. As the pandemic situation escalated further, all BoS members insisted on designing assignments according to government norms to avoid infection. All members also emphasized the use of online digital tools for teaching and learning that benefits students.

The following agenda item is taken as an additional item in the BoS. Considered and Approved.

i) To consider the feedbacks and suggestions provided by the alumni and students of UG and PG classes while designing the syllabus of FY B.Voc JMC and M.Voc MS.

The Chairman initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of incorporating feedback from both Alumni and current students in the syllabus design process. It was noted that their insights and suggestions would greatly contribute to creating a curriculum that aligns with the needs and expectations of the students. Therefore, the BOS members reviewed the feedback and suggestions given by the alumni and students and incorporated the relevant suggestions into the curriculum of F.Y.B.Voc.JMC and M.Voc.MS in Media and Communication Studies department.
