C. College, and Baramati. The meeting took place offline, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Mr. Devidas V. Bhosale, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 3rd April 2021.

Mr. Devidas V. Bhosale read the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 3rd April 2021 and put forward to the BOS members for the approval.

Resolution No. 1: The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. and M. A. programme in accordance with 2022 pattern.

The BOS has discussed the course structure of the BA as per the 2022 pattern credit structure guidelines. Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the 2022 pattern.

Resolution No. 2: The course and credit structure for the B.A. and M. A. programme 2022 pattern has been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.

3. To prepare and approve curriculum of FYBA Semester-I and II (2022 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of SYBA Semester-III and IV, aligning it with the guidelines of the 2022 pattern, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Prof. Dr. C.B. Bhange proposed the addition of the intelligence agencies and military intelligence topic in the course UADS-111(A) and 121(A) course Defence Mechanism of India I-II. Cdr. Dr. Bhushan Dewan recommended the inclusion of a new topic focusing on the new proposed theatre command in the Indian Defence Forces. Lt. Gen. Avinash Chavan suggested changes to include post-Independence development in Indian army, Navy, and Air force. Brigadier Mahajan suggested the inclusion of Cabinet Committee on Political Affairs, Defence Planning Committee in the same course. Prof. Adinath Londhe requested the inclusion

of the internal and external security issues related to India's defence in the UADS-111(B) and 121(B) course. A change was suggested by Brigadier Hemant Mahajan regarding inclusion of historical overview of India-Pakistan and India-China issues in the same course. Furthermore, Lt. Gen. Chavan requested the inclusion of the separate chapter on Indian Ocean security and India's role in the Indian Ocean in the same course.
