 - Rupali Wadekar suggested adding कृदन्त & तद्धित in the point संस्कृत भाषेचा परिचय.
 - 3) Dr. Bharati Balte suggested using गीर्वाणवाणी shows from youtube channel of All India Radio as a Audio-Visual study material.
 - 4) Dr. Mugdha Gadgil suggested using चन्दमामा as संस्कृत नियतकालिक.
 - 5) Pratima Rawal suggested using सप्तवर्णाः as संस्कृत नियतकालिक.
 - 6) Dr. Bharati Balte suggested using संस्कृतव्यवहारसाहस्री for teaching day-to-day sanskrit conversation
 - 7) Dr. Mugdha Gadgil suggested replacing पांडुरंगाष्टकम् with some other stotra and गजस्तत्र न हन्यते with some other story.
