The meeting took place in offline mode, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Ms. Patwardhan S. S., Chairman of the Board of Studies in Dairy Technology, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 07th April, 2022

The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To prepare and approve curriculum of F. Y. B. Voc. Semester-II (2022 pattern)



to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of F. Y. B. Voc. Semester-II, aligning it with the guidelines of the credit structure of 2022 pattern, for the implementation in the academic year 2022-2023. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Ms. Patwardhan suggested the revision of title of UBDT – 123 from Dairy Microbiology to Microbiology of Milk and Milk Products. Ms. More suggested the inclusion of Canning in UBDT – 121 Food Technology. A topic on study of methods of cream separation was included in UBDT – 122 from the suggestions of Dr. Khojare. Mr. Vhorkate proposed a practical on laboratory practices in UBDT – 121 – 2, Microbiology of Milk and Milk Products. The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of F. Y. B.Voc. Semester II (2022 pattern).
