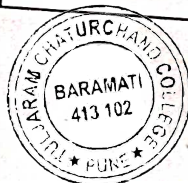
3. To design course and credit structure for the second year UG and PG (Sem. III and IV) in accordance with the NEP – 2020.

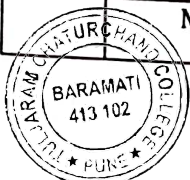

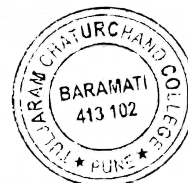
