Resolution No. 1: The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

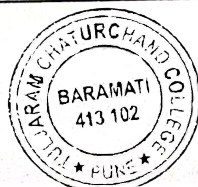
2. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. and M. A. programme in accordance with 2023 NEP pattern.

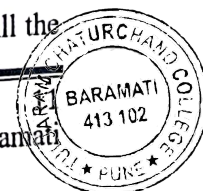
Resolution No.5: The Resolution of Certificate Courses from the online mode of learning from MOOCs and SWAYAM has been unanimously passed.

All the subjects on the agenda were discussed in the meeting, so no issue was raised by any of BOS members.

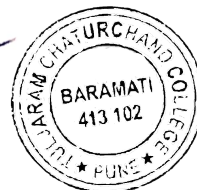


