Dr. Niranjan Shah introduced the importance of adopting a Learning Outcomes-based Approach in curriculum planning and development, aligning with NEP 2020, Learning Outcomes-based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) (UGC) dated 16<sup>th</sup> January 2020, National Credit Framework (NCrF) published in September 2022, and National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF) Published in May 2023 guidelines.

Dr. Janardhan Pawar provided an overview of the key principles and benefits associated with a Learning Outcomes-based Approach.

All the members discussed the implications of adopting a Learning Outcomes-based Approach, including its alignment with the stated guidelines and potential challenges. Dr. Shah highlighted the need for faculty development programs to facilitate the transition to this approach. He also addressed concerns and clarified aspects related to the implementation.
