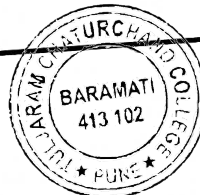

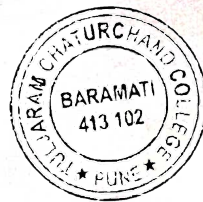

5. Any other matter with the permission of the chair.











During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

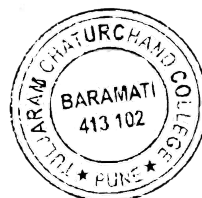
1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 20 April 2023.

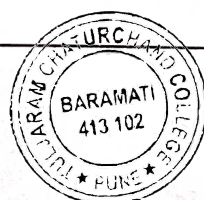

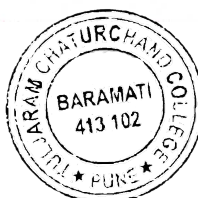

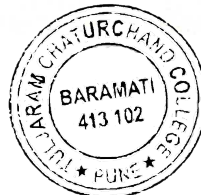
3. To design and approve the curriculum in accordance with the NEP 2020 for FYBA (Semester-I) from the academic year 2023-2024.

During the discussion, some minor changes were suggested by the board members. The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of M.A. Part-I, Semester-I:

According to the guidelines provided by the IQAC of the college, the BOS conducted a comprehensive review and identified best five MOOC courses from the SWAYAM platform related to English language and literature. Detailed discussions were held on each of the identified MOOC courses, considering their applicability and usefulness to the students of SYBA and TYBA. It was decided that the MOOCs will be finalized in the next year while framing the syllabus of SYBA. New MOOCs could be added to SWAYAM next year hence



they will be included in the SYBA and TYBA syllabus later.

Students feedback was collected, and appropriate suggestions were incorporated in the syllabus.

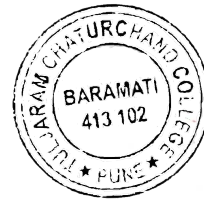
