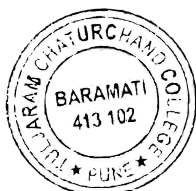

The meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 9th June, 2023.

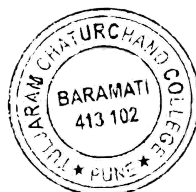

During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members.

- In BOT-151-MJM, Diversity of Phanerogams, there no any suggestions.
- In BOT-152-MJM, Industrial Botany - II, there is no any suggestions.



- In BOT-166-OE, Economic Botany, in cereals instead of rice add bajara. In fiber plants, instead of jute, add *Pentatropi*, in spices, add coriander, ginger and kadipatta. In vegetables, add Pathari and Tandulja. In nuts, add nutmeg instead of walnut.
- In BOT-171-VSC, Plant Tissue Culture, instead of virus free plants write disease free plants.
- In USBT 242, Plant Ecology, add different methods of biodiversity conservation.
- In BOT-561-MJE (B), Plant Ecology and Biodiversity, in Conservation Ecology, add steps taken by T. C. College, Baramati towards conservation of ecology.
- In BOT-551-MJM, Plant Systematics II, remove order Selaginellales.
- In PSBT 242, Industrial Botany, add structure and role as biopesticides.
- Some changes are made in learning outcomes and references.

Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

The Chairman initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of incorporating feedback from both Alumni and current students in the syllabus design process. It was noted that their insights and suggestions would greatly contribute to creating a curriculum that aligns with the needs and expectations of the students. Therefore, the BOS members reviewed the feedback and suggestions given by the alumni and students and incorporated the relevant suggestions into the curriculum of F. Y. B. Sc. Sem. II and M. Sc. I Sem. II (2023 pattern as per NEP-2020), S. Y. B. Sc. Sem. IV (2022 pattern) and M. Sc. II Sem. IV (2022 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.
