MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Notice no. 246, dated 04/10/2023, issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies was successfully held on 30th October 2023 at 11:00 pm in the Department of Defence Studies, T. C. College, and Baramati. The meeting took place offline, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Dr. Devidas V. Bhosale, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Defence and Strategic Studies, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

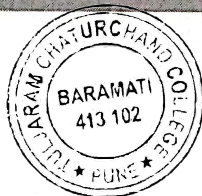
1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 6th June 2023.

Dr. Devidas V. Bhosale read the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 6th June 2023 and put forward to the BOS members for the approval.

Resolution No. 1: The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To design and approve curriculum of F.Y.B.A Semester II (2023 pattern as per NEP-2020) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of FYBA Semester-II, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Prof. Dr. C.B. Bhange proposed the addition of the functions, role and characteristics of the fighting arms topic in the course DEF-151-MJM Defence Organization of India Part-II, as well as recommended the inclusion of a new topic focusing on the ethics and human rights in defence. Prof. Adinath Londhe requested the inclusion of the battalion structure and central armed police forces in the same course. In DEF-152-MJM Dr. Devidas Bhosale proposed the addition of the evaluation of war in each topic in the course as well as major conflicts during the war. Furthermore, Prof. Ramkishan Awad requested the inclusion of the Doklam standoff and Galwan crisis in DEF-152-MJM course. Prof. Amol Lokhande proposed the addition of the maritime security policy and naval strength topic in the course DEF-161-MN Maritime Security of India, as well as recommended the inclusion of a new topic focusing on the Indian Ocean. Prof. Adinath Londhe requested the inclusion of the threats from the neighbours in DEF-166-OE course. Prof. Aniket Damale proposed the addition of the topic regarding Chatrapati Sambhaji and Chatrapati Rajaram in DEF-167-OE. Dr. Devidas Bhosale requested the inclusion of the tools of the defence journalism topic in DEF-171-VSC course. Furthermore, Prof. Dr. C.B. Bhange requested the inclusion of the media ethics in the same course. Prof. Amol Lokhande requested the inclusion of the preventive measures in DEF-176-SEC course.


Resolution No. 3: Considered and Approved
