Certificate of Minority Status Recognition

The institution is required to strictly adhere to the criteria and conditions prescribed under Government Decision, Minority Development Department, **No.MEI-2008/P.No.133/2008/Ka.1**, **dated 4th July 2008**.



- This is to state that Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Baramati, Dist. Pune is run by Anekant Education Society which received minority status on 27th April 2010 with reference No. MEI-2010/174/(29)/P. No.138/2010/Ka.5 from Government of Maharashtra. (Copy of the minority status is attached)
- 2. **Reservation Policy-** Anekant Education Society's Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Baramati, Dist. Pune operates as a minority institution. As a result, 50% of the total seats of students are filled according to the admission rules and guidelines set forth by the State Government of Maharashtra. The remaining 50% of the seats are reserved specifically for students from the Jain community, in line with the institution's minority status.

If the 50% reserved quota for Jain candidates is not completely filled, the remaining vacant seats are filled as per the Government of Maharashtra reservation policy. Additionally, the college offers preferential consideration to students with a sports background for any unfilled seats from the minority quota, ensuring opportunities are extended to deserving candidates in this category.

This approach allows the college to maintain its commitment to providing educational opportunities for both its minority community and students excelling in extracurricular fields such as sports, while adhering to the regulations set by the state.
