The Examinations Department of Anekant Education Society's Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Baramati is an Autonomous Body, By considering the sanctity of the examination, it is endowed with well-defined responsibilities and adequate authority to conduct smooth, fair and timely examinations. The Examinations Department prepares an academic calendar comprehensive schedule of the examinations for UG/ PG Programs.

The Examinations for the academic session 2023-2024 were conducted in strict adherence to the guidelines of UGC under the offline pattern.

From the first semester session 2023-2024, Question Paper which was MCQ based, has been eliminated and only subjective questions (Short and Long Answer Type) will be asked from the subsequent examination. The improvement in the quality of the Marksheet Paper and some more safety features have been introduced in the Marksheet. The timeline and details of all the examinations conducted and the results in the session are presented below in tabular form along with its interpretation.

2. Assessment:

2.1: Theory:

The college conducts two assessments for all sessions per subject per semester -two are tests (IE I and other activities for IE, for 40% of the total marks) and one is an ESE (for 60% of the total marks) Such evaluations are conducted for theory.

2.2: Practical

2.2.1: The practical component for Ist year (NEP 1.0) per subject per one course to each semester, for IInd per subject one course per semester and for IIIrd three practical courses

2.2.2: All practical journals have to be signed by the Faculty-in-Charge at each of these practical's. The HoD along with the FIC will certify these Journals per semester. Journal will be certified only against the completion of 75% attendance at the practical's

2.2.3: A student whose Journal is not certified in a course will be given ZERO marks for the Journal in that Course.

2.2.4: Student is allowed for practical exam with incomplete uncertified/Loss certificate of journal with prior permission of HoDs.

2.2.5: The Journal Marks will be carried forward if a student fails or is absent for the corresponding practical in that course

2.2.6: In a course the ESE Practical Examination will be held at the semester's end.

2.2.7: The Practical ESE marks per Course in the subject would be recorded and maintained by the Department and submitted at the end of the Semester to the Examination Department.

2.2.8: Additional ESE for Practical's will be held within the on-going semester, with permission of the principal if students are represented college in various competitions like Sports, Cultural, NSS, NCC etc.

2.2.9: A student will have to appear for the Practical's of all the Courses of the subject that he/she has chosen.

2.2.10: If a IIIrd year student fails in or is absent for the Practical's in Semester VI, he/she will have to appear for these practical's in the subsequent Semester V of the following academic year

3. Passing Norms


