

Socioeconomic Survey of Anjangaon Village

Program Overview:

The Department of Geography of Tuljaram Chaturchand College, in collaboration with local authorities and community stakeholders, organized a comprehensive socioeconomic survey in Anjangaon, a village located in the Baramati region. The survey aimed to assess the living standards, income sources, education levels, and overall well-being of the households in Anjangaon. This initiative sought to gather crucial data to guide the implementation of development programs that address key challenges in the region. The survey was meticulously planned and coordinated by the faculty members of the Department of Geography, with active participation of 15 students who were trained to collect data effectively. The results of this survey are intended to assist policymakers and stakeholders in designing targeted interventions for sustainable development and improving the quality of life in Anjangaon.

The findings of the survey highlighted significant gaps in employment, education, and infrastructure in the village, pointing to areas in need of urgent attention and development.

Outcomes:

The survey revealed several key findings and outcomes:

1. **Employment:** A majority of the households in Anjangaon relied on agriculture for their livelihood, with limited access to alternative employment opportunities.
2. **Education:** Although literacy rates were relatively high, access to higher education was limited. Many children had to travel long distances to attend secondary and higher education institutions, which hindered their academic progress.
3. **Healthcare:** Healthcare access was suboptimal, with residents facing long waiting times at local clinics and hospitals. The lack of specialized healthcare services was a concern, and many individuals had to travel to Baramati or Pune for medical treatment.
4. **Infrastructure:** Basic infrastructure such as reliable roads, electricity, and sanitation was lacking in some areas of the village, leading to poor living conditions for certain households.

The survey's findings emphasized the need for targeted interventions in areas such as:

- **Job creation and skill development** programs to reduce dependency on agriculture.
- **Improved educational resources** and transportation options to enhance access to education.
- **Expansion of healthcare facilities** and specialized medical services to improve health outcome
