

Report on Blood Donation Camp during Covid-19 Pandemic

On 19 December 2020 with association of HDFC Bank, Sport Department our NSS Department organized the blood donation camp on this occasion. Pune. organized a Blood Donation Camp on 19/10/2023 in collaboration with HDFC Bank.
