Activity Report: Awareness Program on Water Management at Loni Bhapkar Village

Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Department of Geography, on 11th December 2022, in collaboration with the local authorities and villagers of Loni Bhapkar, Baramati, Pune.

Program Overview:

The Department of Geography at Tuljaram Chaturchand College organized an awareness program on water management in Loni Bhapkar village on 11th December 2022. The primary objective of this program was to educate the villagers about the importance of water conservation, sustainable water management practices, and methods to improve water usage efficiency. With water scarcity becoming a pressing issue in rural areas, this initiative aimed to highlight the necessity of conserving water resources, especially in regions that face periodic droughts or water shortages.

The program was designed to provide the community with practical knowledge and solutions for water management at the household and village levels.
