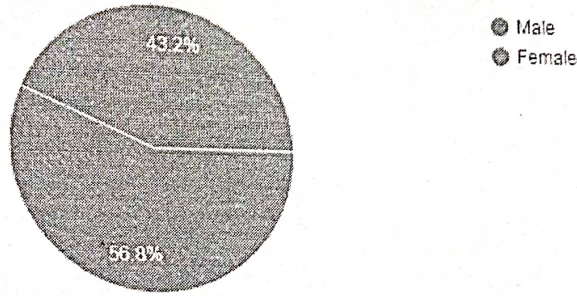

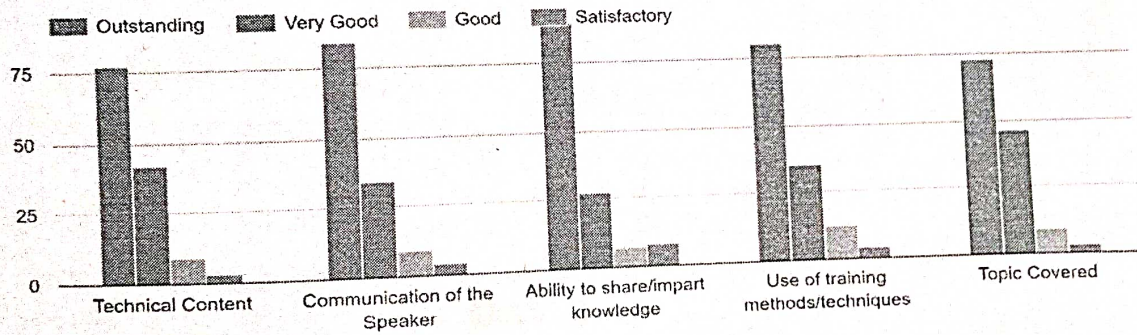

➤ Gender wise distribution of Participants in program

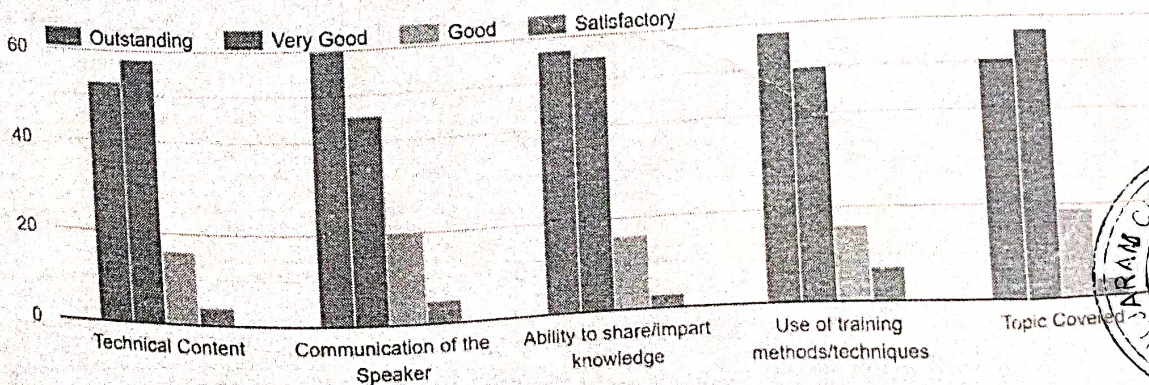
