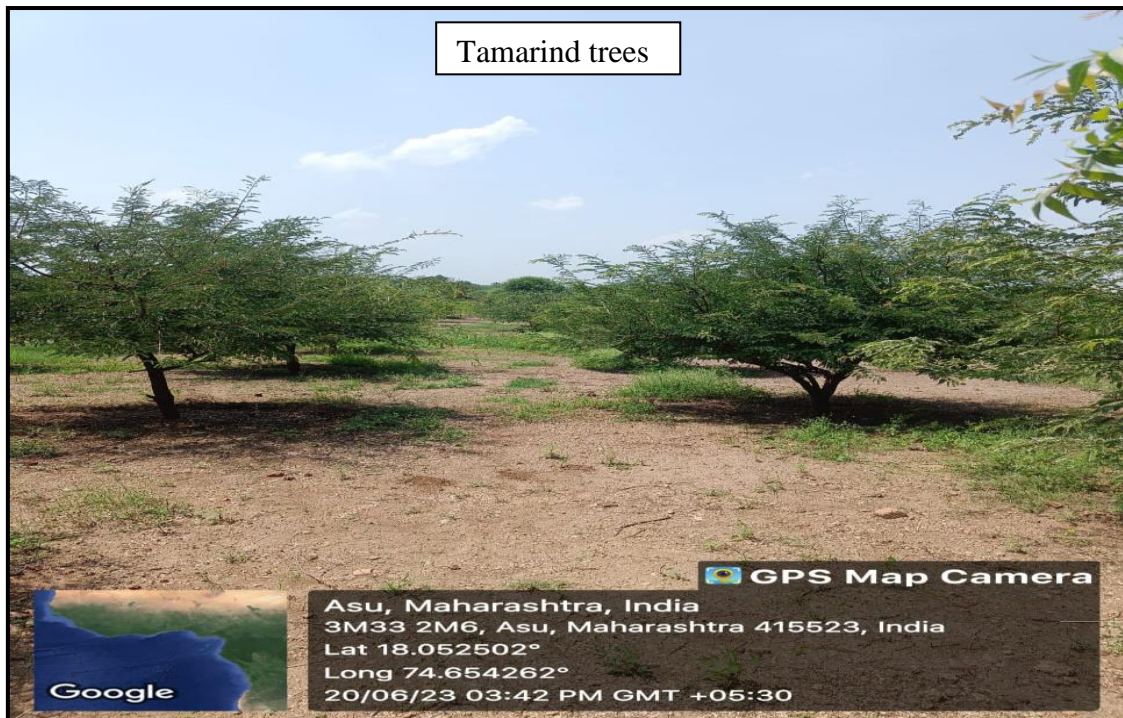

TREE PLANTATION AND CONSERVATION AT ASU VILLAGE, PHLTAN

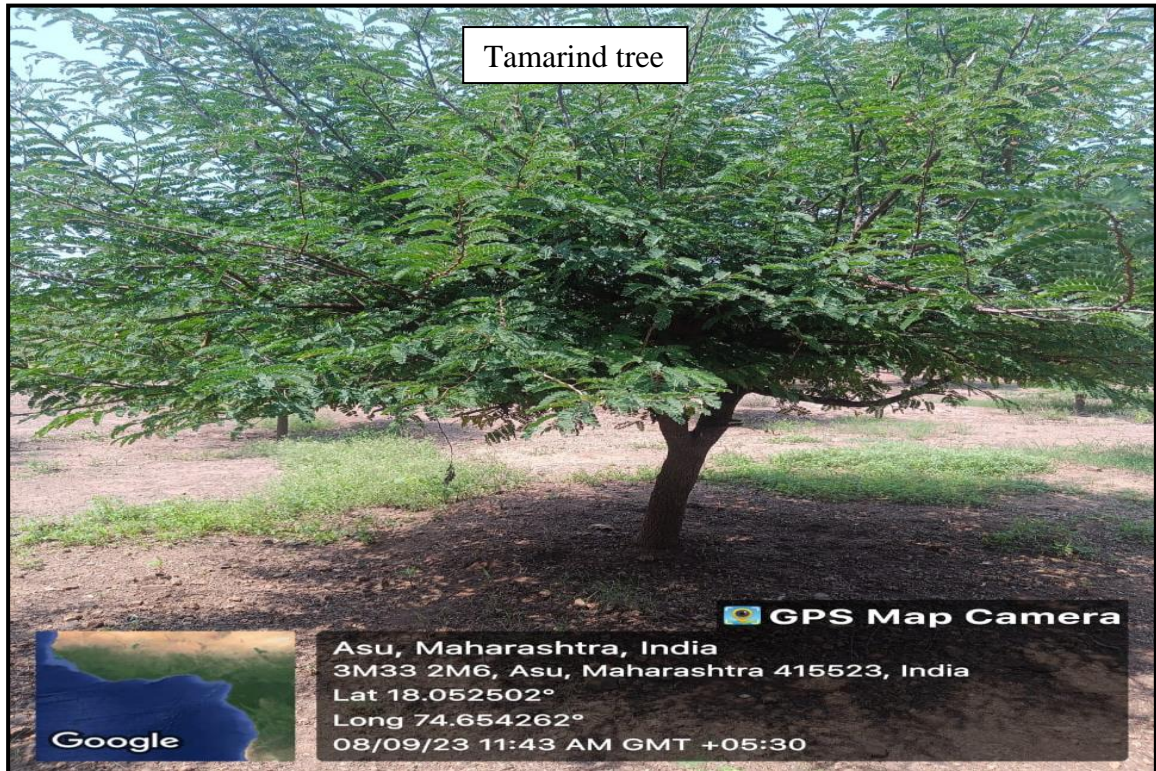
By Department of Economics, June to September of 2023

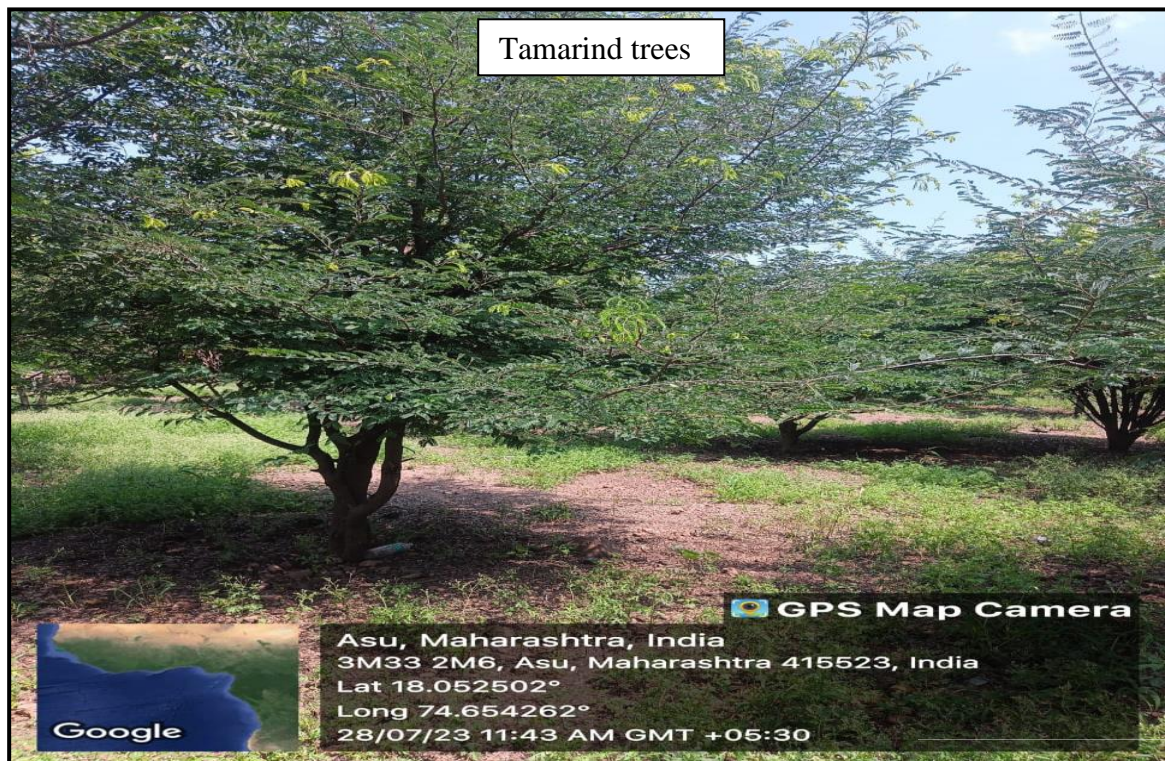


Conservation of Trees at Asu, Phaltan
