**Detail information of the programme/activity:**





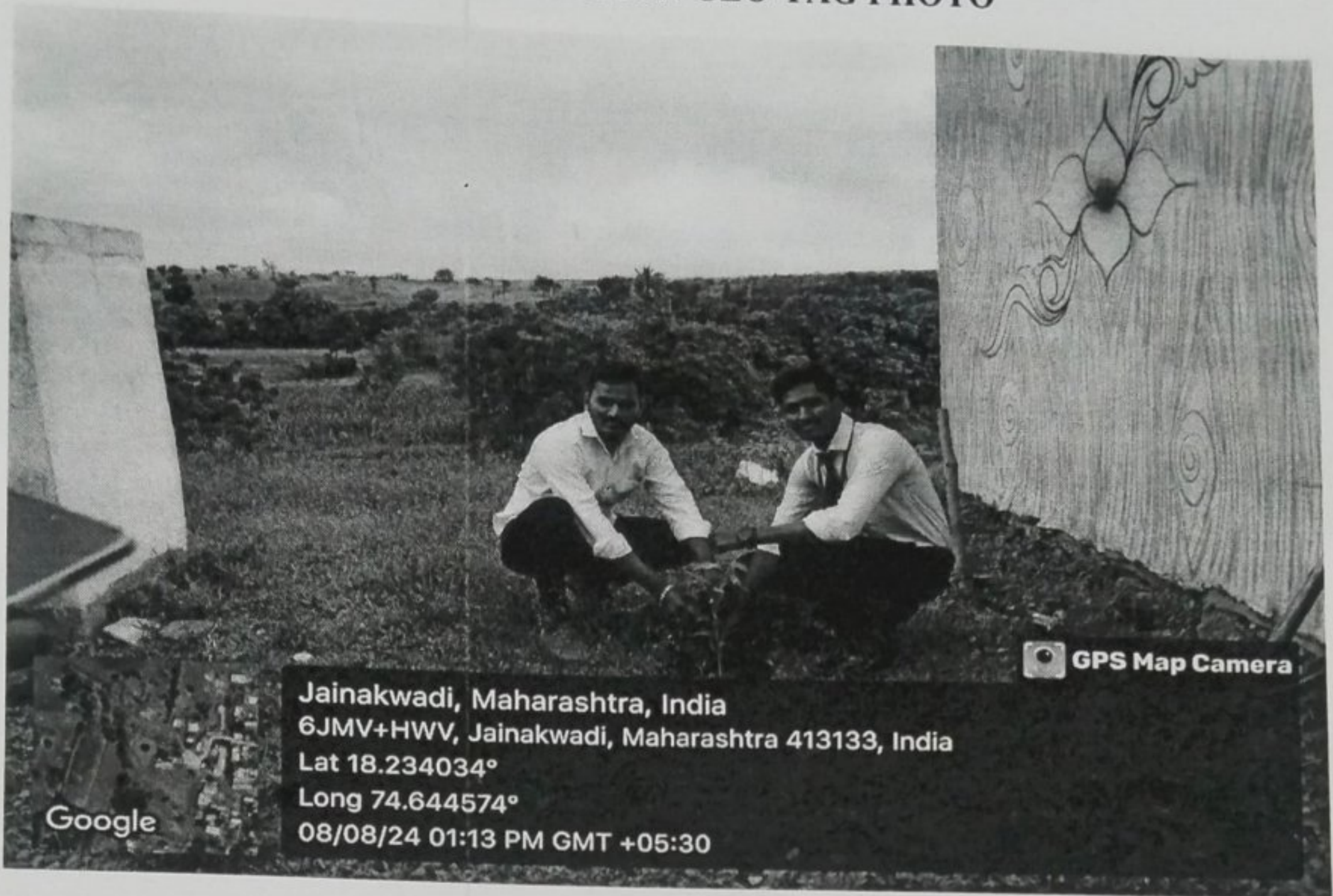
This initiative by the BBA Department marks a significant step towards building a greener future and sets an example for others to follow.
