Under the guidance of Chairman, BoS, Journalism and Mass Communication, Mr. Ranjeet Vijay Pandit, HOD, and Assistant Professor, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BoS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 25th May 2020.

Mr. Ranjit Pandit read the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 25th May 2020 and put forward to the BOS members for the approval.

3. To design the curriculum for T.Y. B.Voc Journalism and Mass Communication (Sem-V and VI) as per 2019 pattern.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of T.Y.B.Voc. Journalism and Mass Communication Semester-V and VI, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), for implementation in the academic year 2021-22. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. The most important suggestion from all the members was to reconsider the number of units and hours with respect to the given credits.

Dr. Madhavi Reddy gave suggestions about which media theories must be include in the course JM 503 Mass Communication at the same time she suggested the module sequence for JM 502 Introduction to Media Research. All members were suggested that there should be some

flexibility in the nature of assignments during the Corona epidemic. During the discussion, Mr. Mithunchandra Chaudhari, who is an expert in Video production, gave valuable inputs on video production. He gave inputs for projects work during pandemic. He also guided the format of writing for the media, asking students to design assignments to motivate them to write.

Dr. Nisha Mudhe gave the inputs for JM 605 Dissertation/In-depth reporting (IDR)

1) Discussion on implementation of skill components of B.Voc. and M.Voc. Curriculum in online teaching mode.


