MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the Notice no. 92, dated 03/07/2023, issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Media and Communication Studies was successfully held on 10th July, 2023 at 1:00 pm in the Department of Media and Communication Studies (DMCS), T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place both online and offline, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Asst. Professor Rahul Chaudhari, Chairman of the Board of Studies in DMCS, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To consider and approve the course structure of the First Year UG and PG (Sem-I and II) according to the NEP 2020.

The BOS has discussed the course structure of the FY B.Voc JMC and M.Voc MS as per the NEP 2020 credit structure guidelines. Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the NEP 2020.

Considered and Approved.

To design and approve the curriculum in accordance with the NEP 2020 for FY B.Voc JMC (Semester-I) from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of FY BVoc JMC Semester-I, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Dr. Sanjay Tambat proposed the removal of the last unit topic/current name from the course JMC-101-MJM Introduction to Mass Communication, and instead recommended the inclusion of a new topic focusing on the Media Effects Theories. Additionally, Dr. Sanjay Tambat requested necessary changes of dividing Units from the theory course 'JMC-102-MJM Introduction to Journalism'. Furthermore, Dr. Sanjay Tambat suggested including equal units in all courses of practical subjects. The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of FYB.Voc JMC Semester I.

Major mandatory subjects, namely JMC-101-MJM: Introduction to Mass Communication, JMC-102-MJM: Introduction to Journalism JMC-103-MJM Basics of Photography; the open elective courses (OE), including JMC-116-OE: Aesthetics of Photography and JMC-117-OE: Mobile Photography; the vocational skill course (VSC), JMC-121-VSC: Computer Application for Media; the skill enhancement course (SEC), JMC-126-SEC: Anchoring Skills; the value education course (VEC), JMC-135-VEC Environmental Pollution and Value Education; and the Indian Knowledge System (IKS), JMC-137-IKS: Indian Folk Media.

Furthermore, it was decided to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of four units for the 2-credit courses and six units for the 4-credit courses. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

Considered and Approved.

3. To design and approve the curriculum in accordance with the NEP 2020 for M.Voc MS (Semester-I) from the academic year 2023-2024.

The board carefully designed and deliberated upon the curriculum of M.Voc MS, Semester-I, aligning it with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. During the discussion, some minor changes were suggested by the board members. Title of the subject, Photography changed to Photography and Photo Editing. The board thoroughly discussed and finalized the syllabus for the following courses of M.Voc MS, Semester-I.

Major mandatory subjects, namely MS-501-MJM: Introduction to Media Studies, MS-502-MJM: Introduction to Journalism, MS-503-MJM: Introduction to Video Production and MS-504-MJM Writing for Media, MS-505-MJM Photography and Photo Editing; Electives Courses i.e. MS-511-MJE (A): Understanding Cinema OR MS-511-MJE (B): Political Communication and MS-512-MJE (A) Camera Techniques OR MS-512-MJE (B) News Reporting and Editing Skills; MS-521-RM: Media Research Methodology.

Furthermore, it was decided to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of three units for the 2-credit courses and six units for the 4-credit courses. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

Considered and Approved.

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4. To adopt Learning Outcomes-based Approach to Curriculum Planning and development as per NEP 2020, LOCF (UGC), NCrF and NHEQF guidelines from the academic year 2023-2024.

The Board of Studies (BOS) engaged in a thorough discussion regarding the adoption of a Learning Outcomes-based Approach to Curriculum Planning and Development, in alignment with the guidelines set forth by NEP 2020, LOCF (UGC), NCRF, and NHEQF. It was acknowledged that this approach would enhance the quality and relevance of the curriculum, making it more responsive to the needs of students and the changing dynamics of the education field. After a detailed discussion, the Board of Studies unanimously resolved to adopt a Learning Outcomes-based Approach to Curriculum Planning and Development **Considered and Approved.**

5. Any other matter with the consent of Chairperson.

The following agenda item is taken as additional item in the BOS.

i) To consider the feedbacks and suggestions provided by the alumni and students of UG and PG classes while designing the syllabus of FYB.Voc JMC and M.Voc MS.

The Chairman initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of incorporating feedback from both Alumni and current students in the syllabus design process. It was noted that their insights and suggestions would greatly contribute to creating a curriculum that aligns with the needs and expectations of the students. Therefore, the BOS members reviewed the feedback and suggestions given by the alumni and students and incorporated the relevant suggestions into the curriculum of F.Y.B.Voc.JMC and M.Voc.MS in Media and Communication Studies department.




