Detail information of the programme:

The Media and Communication Studies department organized an enriching academic visit to Hyderabad on 10th March 2024 to 15th March 2024 for the S.Y and T.Y students of B.Voc Journalism and Mass Communication. This five-day program aimed to provide students with practical exposure to various aspects of media and society while immersing them in the vibrant cultural heritage of Hyderabad. Accompanied by two faculty members, Asst. Prof. Ranjeet Pandit and Asst. Prof. Gayathri Nandhakumar, a total of 29 students embarked on this educational journey.

The itinerary commenced with a captivating exploration of Ramoji Film City on the first day. This iconic film city premises offered students a firsthand experience of the Indian film industry's magic. Students were enthralled as they witnessed the grandeur of the Bahubali set, the charm of the Chandramukhi set, and engaged in various activities such as the Space show, Light camera action event, rain dance, and stunt show. Moreover, strolling through the multiple movie streets and shooting pre-set ups provided invaluable insights into the intricacies of film production.

On the second day, the group explored Hyderabad's rich historical and architectural landmarks. Starting with the serene Birla Temple, they proceeded to delve into the grandeur of Golconda Fort and the majestic Qutub Shahi Tombs. The day concluded with a mesmerizing water laser show at Lumbini Park, followed by a serene boat ride to the Buddha Statue, offering students a blend of history, culture, and entertainment. A campfire arranged at the International Youth Hostel of Secunderabad provided a relaxed environment for reflection and camaraderie.

The third day was dedicated to a cultural immersion, with visits to the Salar Jung Museum and Chowmahalla Palace, offering insights into the opulent lifestyles of Hyderabad's erstwhile rulers. The evening excursion to Charminar and Koti added a contemporary flavor to the historical narrative, allowing students to witness the bustling markets and the vibrant street life of the city.

Respected Sir,



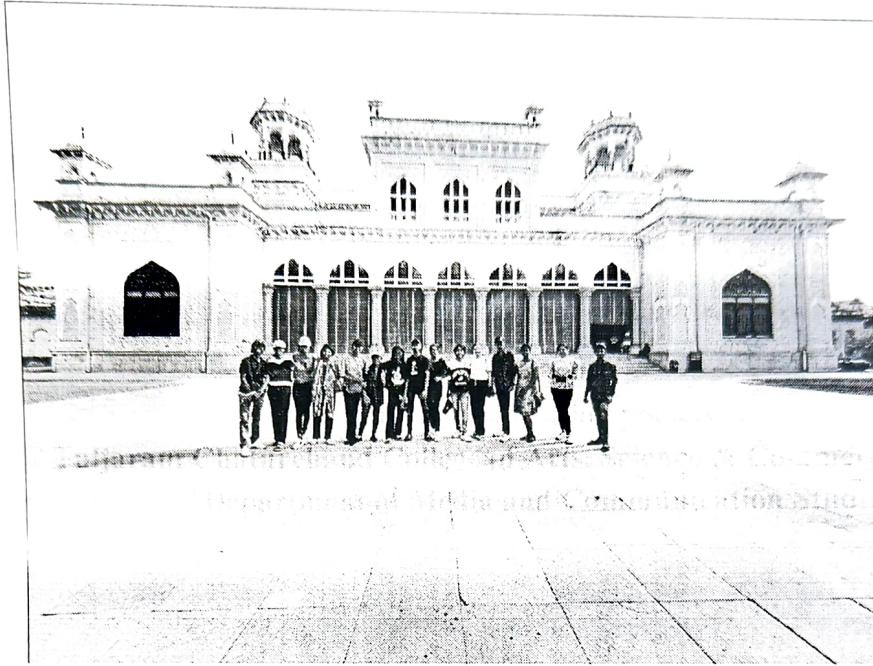

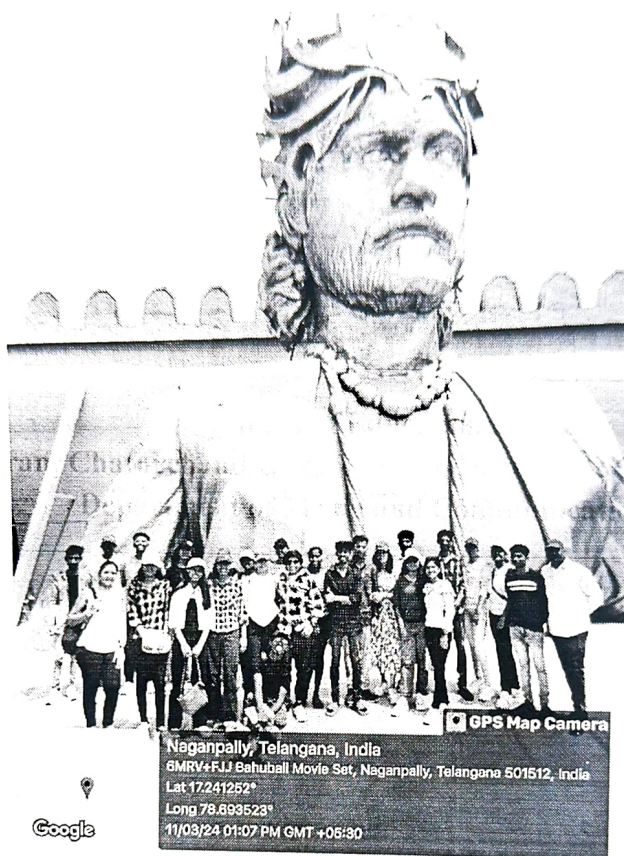
