MINUTES OF THE MEETING

As per the notice no. 471 issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies was successfully held on 07th March, 2024, at 12:00 PM, in the Department of Dairy Technology, T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place in online mode, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. Under the guidance of Asst Prof. Ms. Patwardhan S. S., Chairman of the Board of Studies in Dairy Technology, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives.

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 25th October, 2023.
 Ms. Patwardhan S. S. read the minutes of the BoS meeting held on 25th October 2023 and put forward to the BoS members for the approval.

Resolution No. 1: The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting were approved and confirmed.

2. To design and approve curriculum of T. Y. B. Voc. Semester V (2022 pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.

of T. Y. B. Voc. Programme well in advance before conduction of the BoS meeting. All the members were provided with this draft for further discussion to strengthen the curriculum, aligning it with the guidelines of the credit structure of 2022 pattern, for the implementation in the academic year 2024-2025. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members. Ms. Temkar V. S. dictated each course of the above said curriculum. The topic on Packaging material was removed from UBDT – 351 according to the suggestion of Ms. Patwardhan. Dr. Khojare recommended the inclusion of study of sensory evaluation for dairy products in UBDT – 351-1, Quality Assurance and Waste Management. A study swab test was included in UBDT – 351 – 1 from the suggestions of Ms. More N. B. Ms. Pranoti Anagal suggested the inclusion of topics on butter oil in UBDT – 352, Fat Rich Milk

Products. According to the suggestions of Ms. More, the practical in UBDT -351-2 were arranged in a sequence of manufacturing procedures. A topic of Dairy plant layout and design was added in UBDT -353, Dairy Plant Management.

It was mutually decided by all the BoS members to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of five units for the 04 - credit theory courses and 15 experiments for the 06 - credit practical courses. After thorough discussion and consideration of all the suggestions, the following finalized curriculum was presented for approval during the BoS meeting.

Resolution No. 2: The curriculum of T. Y. B. Voc. Semester V (2022 Pattern) has been unanimously approved by all the BoS members.

3. To design course and credit structure for the S. Y. B. Voc. Semester III and semester IV in accordance with the NEP – 2020.

The BOS has discussed the course structure of the B. Voc. Dairy Technology Programme as per the 2023 pattern (NEP) credit structure guidelines. Taking into consideration the valuable suggestions provided by the BOS members, necessary modifications were made to the course structure. After careful consideration and thorough discussion, the final course structure has been determined, ensuring compliance with the NEP - 2020 guidelines.

Resolution No. 3: The design of course and credit structure for the S. Y. B. Voc. Semester III and Semester IV in accordance with the NEP - 2020 has been unanimously approved by all the BoS members.

4. To design and approve curriculum of S. Y. B. Voc. Semester III (2023 pattern as per NEP - 2020) to be implemented from the academic year 2024 - 2025.

The board deliberately studied and designed the curriculum of S. Y. B. Voc. Semester – III 2023 pattern, aligning it with the guidelines of the credit structure of NEP 2020 guidelines, for the implementation in the academic year 2024-2025. During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members.

Ms. Patwardhan suggested the addition of a topic on workshop tools in DRT -201 – MJM, Dairy Processing Equipment. Both the Indian and western fermented products were included in the same unit according to the suggestion of Mrs. Ganbote S. S. In DRT - 202 - MJM Fermented Milk Products. A practical subject of preparation of fermented milk products was introduced as DRT - 203 - MJM as per the suggestions of Dr. Khojare. Examples of specific vitamin and mineral rich dishes were included in DRT - 204 - MJM as suggested by Ms. Temkar. According to the suggestions of Ms. Pranoti, The theoretical and practical study of chemical attributes of milk was considered for minor subjects of DRT - 211 - MN as Dairy Chmeistry and DRT -212 - MN Chemical Analysis of Milk respectively. For the Open Elective course, DRT - 216 - OE, Dairy Plant Management was considered. And for DRT - 221 -VSC, a course on Entrepreneurship Development was considered by all the BoS members. It was mutually decided among all the BoS members to inculcate study of various attributes of Dairy Industry under the course of DRT - 235 - FP. All the members of BoS were informed that, the courses of Ability Enhancement, Indian Knowledge System and Co-curricular courses would be offered centrally by various departments. The courses offered under AEC are in Marathi, Hindi and Sanskrit language. The generic IKS would be conducted centrally. And co-curricular courses such as Yoga, Physical Education, NSS and NCC would be conducted. Furthermore, it was decided to maintain uniformity in the number of units across all courses, with a total of four units for the 02 - credit theory courses and 15 experiments for the 02 credit practical courses. Finally, it was agreed that the revised curriculum would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.
