The meeting was held under the guidance of Mr. Krushnat Nagare, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Philosophy, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 11th March, 2024.
