
**Board of Studies Meeting**



As per the Notice No. 105 dated 18/06/2024 issued by the college, the meeting of Board of Studies in Political Science was successfully held on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 at 11:00 am in the Department of Political Science, T. C. College, Baramati. The meeting took place in both online and offline mode, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. The meeting was held under the guidance of Dr. Hanumant Phatak, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Political Science, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BOS meeting.

**1. To confirm the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2024.**

Dr. Hanumant Phatak read the minutes of the BOS meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and put forward to the BOS members for the approval.

*Resolution No. 1:* The minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting approved and confirmed unanimously.

**2. To design and approve course and credit structure for the B.A. degree programme in Political Science in accordance with NEP-2.0 (2024 pattern as per NEP-2020).**

The Board of Studies (BOS) members meticulously discussed the new course and credit structure for the B.A. degree program in Political Science. They took into consideration the Government of Maharashtra circular dated March 13, 2024, which introduced three major courses in the first year, and the Circular of SPPU, Pune dated May 2, 2024, regarding credit distribution structures for humanities. After thorough discussion, the following credit distribution structure was finalized.

*Resolution No. 2:* The credit distribution structure for B.A. degree programme in Political Science (2024 pattern) has been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.

**3. To prepare and approve curriculum of FYBA Semester-I and II (2024 NEP pattern) to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.**

This preliminary draft was then shared with all BOS members for their input and suggestions to enhance its quality. During the meeting, Dr. Kallash Mante presented the curriculum on a course-by-course basis, and the recommendations and valuable insights provided by the BOS members were thoughtfully incorporated into the curriculum. In light of the constructive suggestions offered by the BOS members, the curriculum structure underwent necessary revisions. After thorough deliberation and careful consideration, the curriculum of following courses was presented for approval during the BOS meeting.

**Resolution No. 3:** The curriculum for FYBA Semester I and II (2024 pattern) has been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.

**4. To prepare curriculum of Value Education Courses as per UGC guidelines (June, 2023) for Curriculum Framework for Environment Education at UG level.**

The NEP-2020 emphasizes the importance of integrating environmental education into curricula and fostering environmental awareness. It suggests considering environmental education courses as value education courses. In response, the UGC has issued guidelines for the Curriculum Framework for Environmental Education at the undergraduate level. During the BOS meeting, members discussed the UGC guidelines and decided to prepare the curriculum for VEC courses based on these guidelines. Consequently, the syllabi for two value education courses have been prepared: 'POL -105-VEC: Environmental Education' and 'POL -155-VEC: Environmental Awareness.'

**Resolution No. 4:** The curriculum of VEC courses as per UGC guidelines has been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.


**5. To discuss and incorporate the relevant feedbacks of the stakeholders (students, teachers, parents, alumni and employers) in the curriculum.**

The Chairman initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of incorporating feedback from both Alumni and current students in the syllabus design process. The department created a curriculum feedback form and distributed it to students, teachers, parents, alumni, and employers. Subsequently, the stakeholders filled out the feedback forms. It was noted that their insights and suggestions would greatly contribute to creating a curriculum that aligns with the needs and expectations of the students. Therefore, the BOS members reviewed the feedback and suggestions given by the alumni and students and incorporated the relevant suggestions into the curriculum of F.Y.B.A. Political Science.
