College, Baramati. The meeting took place in both online and offline mode, adhering to the guidelines and protocols set by the college. The meeting was held under the guidance of Dr. Sandip P. Chordiya, Chairman of the Board of Studies in Zoology, the meeting commenced with a warm welcome to all the esteemed members, followed by a brief introduction of the meeting's objectives

During the meeting, fruitful discussions were held on the items mentioned in the circulated agenda. We are pleased to inform you that the following resolutions were made during the BoS meeting.
