

SOPs of Community Engagement Project:

In NEP 2020 (2023 Pattern) we are offering to UG (Second Year -Fourth Semester) students Community Engagement Project (CEP) for TWO (2) credits i.e. 50 Marks. The total time allocation for the student to carry out Community Engagement Project is 60 hours. The actual field work should be carried out after college hours or on holidays. Project topics should be assigned to individual students or groups of students (2 or 3 students in one group). Students should compile all relevant data and carry out its analysis. This is a compulsory subject in our syllabus, passing the Community Engagement Project is a MUST to complete the degree.

Finally, it was agreed that the SOPs and guidelines would be submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.

SOPs of Research Project:

- 1) Choose a research topic in consultation with your guide.
- 2) Write a research proposal including the objectives, hypothesis, significance, and expected outcomes of the project.
- 3) Conduct a thorough literature review using academic databases, journals, and books.
- 4) Analyze the collected data using appropriate statistical tools and software.
- 5) Interpret the results, comparing them with the literature review and objectives set in the proposal.
- 6) Create a PowerPoint presentation summarizing your research project.
- 7) The presentation should cover the objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions in a clear and concise manner.

During the discussion, certain modifications were suggested by the board members and are implemented in the SOPs and guidelines for Research Project (Credit - 6).

Finally, it was agreed that the SOPs and guidelines for Research Project (Credit - 6) would submitted to the academic council of the college for approval.
