**6.To prepare SOPs and Guidelines for Field Project and On Job Training (OJT) for M.A. I and Research Project (RP) for M.A. II (2023 pattern as per NEP-2020) to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.**

The Board of studies has developed SOPs and guidelines for the Field Project and On-the-Job Training(M.A-I, Semester II) as well as for Research Projects (M.A-II, Semester III and IV).The SOPs for On-the-Job Training were created in accordance with the UGC guidelines on internships (2023) and the Government of Maharashtra's Internship Policy Resolution dated 5<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024.The guidelines and SOPs for Research Projects were formulated based on the directives provided by the UGC and SPPU, Pune. Additionally, the general guidelines for Research Projects, Field Projects, and On-the-Job Training issued by the college's Internship Cell were also considered. The draft of the Field Project SOPs and guidelines was prepared by Dr.Vijaykumar

Shinde, while the SOPs and guidelines for the On-the-Job Training and Field Projects were developed with contributions from Mr. D. B. Khomane and Dr. G. M. Dhame. Separate formats for the Research Projects, Community Engagement Projects and Field Projects were also created.

**Resolution No.6:**The SOPs and Guidelines for RP, FP and OJT have been unanimously approved by all members of the BOS.

**7.To prepare and approve curriculum of skill development course (SDC) for semester III and IV of PG programme.**

SPPU, Pune has issued a circular to introduce Skill Development Courses for Semester III and IV of PG programs as additional credit courses, each carrying two credits. The Board of Studies (BOS) members discussed the types of skills that PG students should acquire. After through deliberation, it was decided to introduce "Communication and Enhancing Personality and Psychological First Aid" as a skill development course. **8. To discuss and incorporate the relevant feedbacks of the stakeholders (students, teachers, parents, alumni and employers) in the curriculum.**



With no further issues to discuss, the BOS meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr.Dhame G.M.


