The draft of the CEP SOPs and guidelines was prepared by Dr. A. S. Jadhav, while the SOPs and guidelines for the FP were drafted with contributions from Dr. A. S. Magar and Mr. V. D. Chavan. Separate formats for the CEP and FP were also created.

6. To prepare SOPs and Guidelines for Field Project (FP) and On Job Training (OJT) for M.A./M.Sc.-I and Research Projects (RP) for M.A./M.Sc.-II (2023 pattern as per NEP-2020) to be implemented from the academic year 2024-2025.

The Board of Studies has developed SOPs and guidelines for the Field Project and On-the-Job Training (M.A./M.Sc.-I, Semester II) as well as for Research Projects (M.A./M.Sc.-II, Semester III and IV). The SOPs for On-the-Job Training were created in accordance with the UGC guidelines on internships (2023) and the Government of Maharashtra's Internship Policy Resolution dated 5th and 29th February 2024. The guidelines and SOPs for Research Projects were formulated based on the directives provided by the UGC and SPPU, Pune. Additionally, the general guidelines for Research Projects, Field Projects, and On-the-Job Training issued by the college's Internship Cell were also considered. The draft of the Field Project SOPs and guidelines was prepared by Dr. A. S. Magar, while the SOPs and guidelines for On-the-Job Training and Field Projects were developed with contributions from Dr. A. S. Jadhav and Mr. V. D. Chavan. Separate formats for the Research Projects, Community Engagement Projects, and Field Projects were also created.

SPPU, Pune has issued a circular to introduce Skill Development Courses for Semester III and IV of PG programs as additional credit courses, each carrying two credits.
