An Institutional Ethics Committee is a body that ensures the ethical conduct of research involving humans, animals, chemicals, and biological substances. It serves as a regulatory and advisory body that reviews and monitors research projects to ensure compliance with ethical guidelines and legal requirements.

### **1. Animal Ethics :**

Oversees research involving animals to ensure humane treatment and compliance with local and national guidelines

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Reviewing research protocols involving animals.
- Ensuring ethical treatment and minimal harm to animals.
- Monitoring animal care facilities.
- Approving experiments based on ethical considerations and scientific justification.

### **2. Chemical Safety :**

Focuses on research involving chemicals to ensure safety for humans and the environment.

- Assessing risks associated with chemical use.
- Ensuring proper disposal and handling of hazardous substances.
- Reviewing protocols for chemical safety.
- Monitoring laboratories and research for compliance with regulations.

### **3. Bioethics :**

- **Purpose:** Ensures that research involving biological materials, human subjects, or genetic materials follows ethical standards.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Reviewing biomedical research involving human subjects or biological samples.
  - Addressing issues related to consent, confidentiality, and human rights.
  - Ensuring compliance with ethical standards in clinical trials.
