Case Study 3: Tree Counting Census Activity

The Department of Environment and Climate Change of the Government of Maharashtra, in collaboration with Baramati Municipal Council and Tuljaram Chaturchand Arts, Science and Commerce College, organized a tree-counting campaign as part of the 'My Earth' initiative. This campaign, conducted by the college's National Service Scheme (NSS), National Cadet Corps (NCC), and other student volunteers, aimed to assess the green cover within the 19 wards of Baramati Municipal Council.

The campaign took place from 24th February 2020 to 21st March 2022, with 26 groups of 4 volunteers each, totaling 104 volunteers. These volunteers worked on the field, conducting a physical count of trees within the limits of the Baramati Municipal Council. The town planning department provided ward-wise maps and locations to guide the volunteers, ensuring comprehensive coverage across all 19 wards.

This initiative contributed to better understanding of Baramati's urban greenery and promoted environmental awareness among students and the community.



Report on Tree Counting Census

Date:15/03/2022

India is a developing country; Maharashtra is a one of the leading states in this developing transformation. Considering the available population and their needs, various projects are underway to maintain optimal infrastructure to balance the demand and supply of daily needs, including construction of new roads or railways or widening of existing corridors, while various projects are underway to balance the environment also. As a part of it, the Department of Environment and Climate Change of the Government of Maharashtra is implementing an initiative called 'My Earth'.

The scheme is being implemented in Maharashtra with the aim of enabling the citizens to make conscious efforts for the betterment of the environment by educating the citizens about the effects of climate change and environmental problems and to enable them to make conscious efforts to improve the environment. As a part of this, with Baramati municipal council Tuljaram Chaturrachand Arts, Science and Commerce College's ,National Service Scheme, National Cadet Corps and other student volunteers of the college carried out tree counting campaign in '19 wards of Baramati Municipal council from 24th February 2020 to 21st March 2022..

According to the World Bank report, and as per government report the forest in India covers, the tree cover of the country is slightly increased. (2.85 percent) in 2017. More over As per report published by Government of India the total forest cover in India as per 2019 assessment In Maharashtra state all tree stands with canopy density over 10% [1]. To validate current status of Trees located in the premises of Baramati Municipal Council, Baramati the Tree counting with Geo tagging campaign is carried out. To execute such campaign very first understand the definition of tree.

Moreover, those people who are going to count tree must be identify tree's classification and Categories. With this consideration, there is need to make Identification chart of trees.

Resources:

To execute tree counting campaign following resource collect.

- 1. Prepare an Identification chart of tree with the help of expert of Botany Department.
- 2. Conduct Physical training program of tree counting and geo tagging with the Environmental Science and Geography Department.
- 3. Baramati municipal Council arranged Measuring Tapes and other sources like Geo-tagging camera application etc for respective field work of tree census.

Physically (26) groups in which each group have 4 volunteers. so *total (104) volunteers* worked on *field* within the limit of 19 wards of Baramati municipal council area whose ward wise map and locations are provided by town planning department of BMC.













