

Subject: A report on 5 days workshop for teachers at the Bahai Academy, Panchgani

Dear Sir,

Under Faculty Development programme 18 faculty members of Arts, Science and Commerce disciplines (Senior and junior wings) participated in the 5 days Workshop for the Teachers on "Education in Universal Human Values" organized through collaboration of Tuljaram Chaturchand College of Arts, Science and Commerce Baramati and the Bahai Academy, Panchgani from 19-23 August 2019.

The objectives of the workshop were as follows:

- 1) To enhance moral capabilities and ethics.
- 2) To improve inter-personal relationship with students and colleagues.
- 3) To develop positive attitudes.
- 4) To boost their professional development and.
- 5) To become Mentors of Education in Universal Human Values.

1. Study kit @ Rs. 850/- per person

2. Training fee @ Rs.1150/- per person
(18 × Rs.1150) = **Rs. 20,700/-**
3. Boarding and Lodging @ 5,000/- per person
(This includes stay at deluxe dormitory breakfast, lunch, dinner, tea and refreshment twice in a day)
(18 × Rs.5000) = **Rs.90,000/-**
4. Miscellaneous expenses: Rs. 275/- per person
(18 × Rs.275) = **Rs. 4,950/-**

Total payable: Rs.1,30,950/- (Rs. One Lakh Thirty Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Only)
