### National Service Scheme Regular Activity Held in 2021-22

**Date: 20/11/2021**

In an effort to promote democratic participation and ensure that all eligible citizens have the opportunity to vote, a New Voter Registration Camp was organized by the National Service Scheme (NSS) in collaboration with the local Tehsil Office. The camp, held on 20/11/2021 aimed at registering new voters, particularly targeting youth, first-time voters, and underrepresented communities. The initiative was designed to simplify the voter registration process and raise awareness about the importance of electoral participation. **More than 200 students** were registered as new registration voter. The camp was held at T.C. College Campus, centrally located to ensure maximum accessibility for residents. A team from the Tehsil Office, along with volunteers from the NSS, set up registration desks and kiosks to assist attendees. Total 24 NSS Volunteers were working in the activity. The participants primarily included: First-time voters, particularly students from local schools and colleges. Individuals who recently turned 18 and became eligible to vote. Citizens who had moved and needed to update their voter registration. Residents from remote and rural areas who face challenges in accessing government services. The camp was a resounding success, registering 210 new voters over the course of the day. The impact of the camp can be summarized as follows:



1. **Increased Voter Enrolment:** A significant number of young and first-time voters enrolled in the electoral rolls, enhancing their participation in upcoming elections.
2. **Streamlined Process:** The presence of Tehsil Office officials helped in the immediate verification of documents, reducing the waiting time for registration and ensuring accuracy.
3. **Awareness Among Youth:** Many students who attended the camp were previously unaware of the voting process. The camp encouraged them to actively participate in their civic duties and educated them on the power of their vote.
4. **Community Engagement:** The collaboration between the NSS and Tehsil Office fostered a sense of community involvement, with volunteers enthusiastically participating in raising awareness. The camp was also visited by local community leaders, who appreciated the effort.
5. **Ease of Access:** By bringing voter registration services directly to the community, the camp removed the barriers that many rural and marginalized individuals face when accessing government services.

The New Voter Registration Camp organized by NSS and the Tehsil Office was a valuable initiative that contributed to increasing voter participation in the region. The collaboration between NSS, government officials, and volunteers demonstrates the power of collective effort in promoting civic responsibility and ensuring that every eligible citizen has the opportunity to vote. The camp's success sets a positive precedent for future voter registration drives and reinforces the importance of engaging young citizens in the electoral process.
