Students Council Committee Report

Academic Year: 2023-24

As per the University Act (2016), under the guidance of Hon. Principal Prof. (Dr.) Avinash Jagtap, the student council for the academic year 2023-24 was established, consisting of 76 meritorious class representatives (C.R.) and principal-nominated active student members from various activities and extracurricular committees such as NCC, NSS, and cultural activities. On Friday, 20/10/2024, the 76 student council members participated in the election process and elected two general secretaries:

All student council members actively participated in committees formed by the principal and heads of various academic and extracurricular committees. Throughout the year, they organized and contributed to activities such as NSS camps, workshops, editing *Anekant* magazine, IQAC Yuva Mahotsav, conferences, guest lectures, sports events, and cultural events. The council members were guided by the Vice Principal Dr. Ashok Kalange (Election Officer) and IQAC Co-ordinator Dr. Yogini Mule.



Student Council Report

Academic Year: 2022 -23

The main aim of the framing student council is to give students an opportunity to develop their leadership skills by their direct involvement in college activities. Under the kind guidance of Principle Dr. C.V. Murumkar, 82 members of student council played a significant role in maintaining safe and healthy atmosphere in college campus and well-functioning of the college.

The Student Council members were selected based on merit, with Class Representatives (CRs) from all classes being nominated by the Principal and the Head of Extra-Curricular Activities. The principal also appointed an election committee, led by Chief Election Officer Professor Dr. Ashok Kalange, to oversee the election process. On September 30th, 2022, two Miss. Akshada Kulkarni and Mr. Jambhulkar Bharat General Secretaries were elected by voting.

Throughout the academic year 2022-2023, the Principal, Vice-Principal, and IQAC Coordinator provided ongoing support to the Student Council in conducting various academic and administrative activities within the college.

Academic Year: 2021-22

The college has a proactive Student Council that assists the Principal, Head of Extra-Curricular Activities, Heads of various departments, and faculty in planning, organizing, and executing student-cantered activities. The Council also addresses and resolves concerns related to the teaching-learning and evaluation process, administrative matters, and basic requirements, ensuring the smooth functioning of the college.

The Student Council is formed by nominating one student per class based on academic merit, along with representatives from sports, NSS, NCC, cultural activities, and the Student Development Board. In total, six student representatives are appointed by the principal.

The principal also appoints an election committee, through which two General Secretaries Miss. Tejashri Lonkar and Mr. Saurabh Pandhare are elected by voting from among 76 the Student Council members. These members are further nominated to various committees, including IQAC, the Anti-Ragging Committee, ICC, the Discipline Committee, the Workshop Organizing Committee, and the Events Organizing Committee.
