

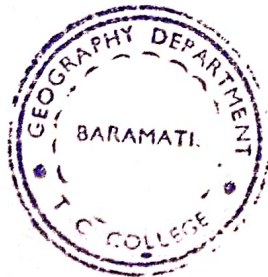

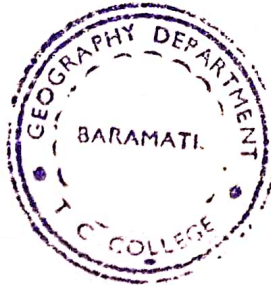

**Bird Watching Activity Report**

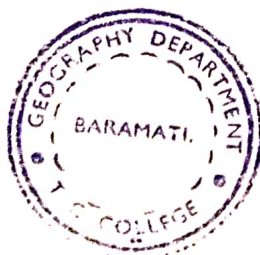
The bird watching expedition organized by the Nature Club, Department of Geography at Bhigwan, Maharashtra, on Thursday 24/01/2024 proved to be an enlightening and enriching experience for all participants. Total 14 students and 2 teachers were participated in this activity. Mr. V.D. Chavan and Miss. A.S. Tamboli organized this event. Bhigwan is renowned for its rich avian diversity, particularly during the winter months when migratory birds flock to the region. The expedition aimed to explore and appreciate the natural beauty of Bhigwan while observing and documenting various bird species. The expedition commenced in the early hours as participants gathered at the designated meeting point. Equipped with binoculars, cameras, and field guides, the group embarked on their journey to explore the birding hotspots around Bhigwan.

Bhigwan did not disappoint in terms of bird diversity. Participants were thrilled to spot a myriad of avian species, including but not limited to:

- Greater Flamingos: These majestic birds adorned the wetlands in large numbers, presenting a captivating sight against the backdrop of the rising sun.
- Painted Storks and Spoonbills: Participants marveled at the elegance of painted storks and the distinctive bill shapes of spoonbills as they foraged in the shallow waters.
- Marsh Harriers and Black-Winged Stilts: The graceful flight of marsh harriers and the slender profile of black-winged stilts added to the charm of the expedition.
- Several other migratory and resident bird species added depth to the birding experience, providing ample opportunities for observation and photography.

Throughout the expedition, knowledgeable guides provided valuable insights into bird behavior, habitat conservation, and the significance of Bhigwan as a critical bird sanctuary. Participants gained a deeper understanding of the interconnectedness between avian life and wetland ecosystems.

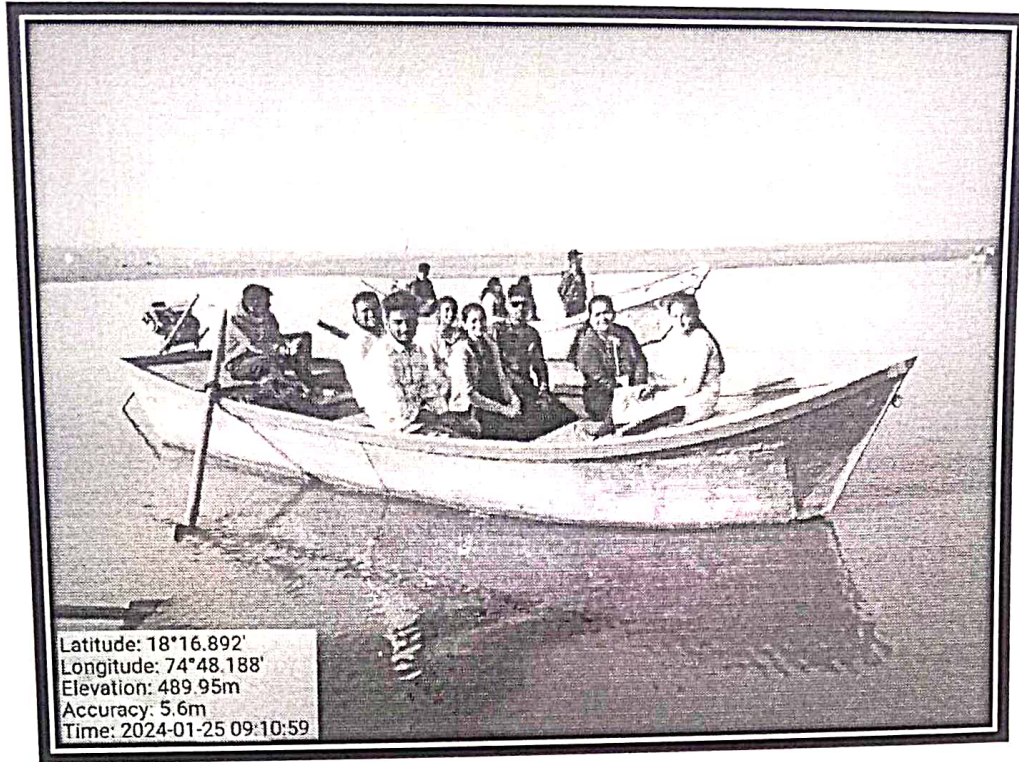
