**Subject: Report of Completion of Credit System Courses.**

Respected Sir,

We all are very much thankful to you for giving us an opportunity to conduct Credit System Course at PG level. As per your guidance we had scheduled the Human Rights-I and Cyber Security – I courses for all PG students from 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2021 to 11<sup>th</sup> May 2021. We had scheduled daily 3 lectures for Human Rights-I (from 9.00 am to 11.00 am) and 3 lectures for Cyber Security-I (from 11.30 am to 1.30 pm). During the schedule total 30 lectures were conducted for Human Rights-I and 30 lectures for Cyber Security-I as well. Both the courses were conducted through online mode (Google Classroom). 930 students (including backlog) were joined the lectures.

The online examination of both the courses were conducted on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021 through online mode. There were 903 students (including backlog) appeared for the examination.
