TREE PLANTATION DRIVE

Activity by Economics Department on 02/09/2019

Tree plantation is a powerful tool for combating climate change, protecting ecosystem and fostering healthier communities. Regular tree plantation contributes to global reforestation efforts and make our earth cleaner and greener. Also, tree plantation helps in enhancing the beauty of the college campus. The Economics department of the college carried out a tree plantation drive at Asu village in Phaltan Tehsil. The village is a historical place situated near the banks of Nira river. The plantation was conducted to protect our environment, to promote biodiversity, and raise awareness about the importance of trees in mitigating climate change. The drive was organized on 5th September 2021 with the support of college authorities, villagers of Asu gram panchayat, faculty members, and student of Economics department.

TREE PLANTATION DRIVE REPORT-2

Considering the need of environment protection, the students and faculty members of the Department of Economics of Tuljaram Chaturchand College decided to embark a tree plantation drive. For this tree plantation drive, this year (2019-20) Aasu village in Phaltan Tehsil was selected. Aasu is a historical village situated on the banks of Nira River. This village was chosen due to the co-operation and willingness expressed by the Gram Panchayat functionaries.

- 1. The Preliminary work: This initiative was led by Dr. Jotiram Ghadage. He convinced the students to participate in this annual activity of the department. Students hailing from Aasu village, namely, Mr. Mahesh Kamble, Mr.Atul Sonawane, Mr. Vikas Sonawane, Mr. Tejas Phalke assured about the help of the Gram Panchayat in this regard. Dr. Ghadage was also encouraged by the guidance he received from our Principal Dr. Chandrashekhar Murumkar sir.
- 2. Role of Sarpanch and other dignitaries of Gram Panchayat

 The Sarpanch of the Village Mr. Mahadeo Sakunde, Up-Sarpanch Mr.Nitin Godase and other elected members of the Gram Panchayat, Police Patil, President of the Tanta Mukti Abhiyan, Gramsevak and other Social Workers wholeheartedly welcomed the organization of this drive. They assured that a land of around 1 acre would be made available for the Tree Plantation Drive for which the Gram Panchayat cleared the thorny offshoots from the area reserved for Gay-ran or Grazing Land. The Gram Panchayat also assured us that they will provide logistics support such as tractor, water tank and other tools required for this drive. As well as they assured that they will provide snacks to all the participants.
- 3. Actual Tree Plantation on 02 September, 2019: A total 44 students who reside in different villages gathered at the Bus Stand of Baramati at 7.30 a.m. on 02 September, 2019. Then all these students alongwith the 7 faculty members moved to Aasu S.T. Bus at 9.00 am. They were received at the village by the Sarpanch of the village. The students were taken for a round of village and the Panchayat Functionaries were acquainted with the staff and students. After this students were served with snacks and tea in the Anganwadi No.5.

The actual work of tree plantation started around 11.00 am. Students carried the saplings from the Panchyat Office to the spot of tree plantation. Pirst students identified 100 places where the trees were to be planted. Then these places were cleared of weeds. Small pits were dug and saplings were planted at the hands of various dignitaries such as the Gram Panchayat Members, Police Patil, Tanta Mukti Presidents, Social Workers. Our Principal e and International Plant Scientist Dr. Murumkar had guided us about the precautions to be taken while planting trees during our last Tree Plantation Drive at Barhanpur. At the special request of the Gram Panchayat only Tamarind Saplings which were of 2 years old were chosen for plantation. Though we also planted Eucalyptus, Pimpal and Vatvruksha trees at some places. As committed the Gram Panchayat provided all the necessary logistics support, water and other miscellaneous things required for the plantation. The students very carefully completed their task in groups and enjoyed the activity a lot.

4. Valedictory function: After finishing with the plantation work the teachers and some representative students were felicitated by the Gram Panchatat in the Kaleshwar Mandir Sabha Mandap. Head of the Department-Dr. Samadhan Patil, Prof. Krushna Kulkarni and Dr. Ghadage were felicitated. Up-Sarpanch of the village Mr. Nitin Godse and Dr. Jotiram Ghadage expressed their feelings on the occasion. Mr. Godse thanked the college for choosing their village for Tree Plantation. He also assured that Gram Panchayat would take good care of the trees planted and not even one sapling would be wasted. He also expressed interest in organizing a Camp of NSS in the village. The students and faculty members departed the venue with a new energy and with a new mission of undertaking more such initiatives in the future.
