Department of Zoology was established in the year 1964 and affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune (then, University of Pune). Department offers Undergraduate degree programme (B.Sc. Zoology) since 1981 and offers Post Graduate degree program (M.Sc.) in three areas including Entomology, Animal Physiology, and Genetics.

Department of Zoology has well equipped UG and PG laboratories (Dr. H. G. Khorana Laboratory. Dr. Salim Ali Laboratory & Sir Ronald Ross Laboratory) with necessary laboratory equipments like varieties of microscopes, microtome machine, Hot Air ovens, incubators, centrifuge machine, PCR, electrophoresis, autoclave unit, Laminar Air Flow, etc. All laboratories are well ventilated and follow necessary safety measures. Department also houses the QR coded animal museum that has rare & common specimens from almost all classes under most of the phyla.

The department offers a congenial environment for knowledge development, research training and for individual growth. It has an excellent complement of teaching by the faculty who are involved in basic and applied research in different areas of Zoology.
